



## Call for research proposals on future cities and technology

The Metropolis Project is soliciting proposals for research funding. A 2-page description of the work to be conducted, along with a detailed budget not exceeding USD 100,000, should be sent to <a href="mailto:metronews@princeton.edu">metronews@princeton.edu</a> by December 6, 2021. Please send any inquiries to the same email address. We expect to be able to support one project. The scope of the work would ideally be limited to 1 year.

Particularly encouraged are requests to develop, apply, or integrate novel technologies that can make cities more resilient, sustainable, livable and equitable. We define technology broadly to include, for example, sensors, materials, computational and systems models, statistical and machine learning analytics, networks, among others. Proposals that involve two or more Princeton faculty or senior researchers from different departments, with comparable effort commitment, working to integrate their expertise in unique and novel ways to solve urban challenges will be prioritized for funding.
